

# Do Charter Buses Have WiFi, Charging Outlets, or USB Ports?

If you're considering renting a coach or charter bus, you probably have some questions. One of the most common ones is, "Do charter buses have WiFi?"

If that's the case, you're probably also wondering about USB ports and outlets.

In our ever-connected society, these are important questions to answer before locking in. Rest assured, you've come to the right place.

Here's everything you need to know about the equipment on our charter buses.

## Do Charter Buses Have WiFi?

The short answer to this question is yes. A vast majority of coach and charter buses are WiFi-capable, including many of our options.

But Wi-Fi comes at a cost.

If you want to enable Wi-Fi on your coach bus rental, you'll need to pay an extra fee. This will be determined during booking when you request a free quote. It's always a good idea to familiarize yourself with charter bus pricing to avoid any surprises.

Some people believe the Wi-Fi on buses is weaker than usual, but that's not the case. Each bus has its own Wi-Fi router, no different than the one you might have in your home. The Wi-Fi should be just as capable as the connection in your home.

The only major difference is the number of people using the Wi-Fi. If everyone on the bus is using it at once, it's going to use up more bandwidth. This, of course, means slower load times.

But bus Wi-Fi is an invaluable tool, especially for work outings. It allows you to get work done on the go without using up your mobile data or Wi-Fi hotspot. The upsides always outweigh the downsides, and stories of constantly slow connections are simply false most of the time.

Bus Wi-Fi allows you to stay entertained on the slower parts of a bus trip, too. Watch Netflix, play online games, and listen to Spotify without using a single KB of data.

## Modernizing Bus Rides

Buses have come a long way in the past decade or so.

It used to be that there were no outlets, USB ports, or any real amenities on buses both public and private. Now, these things are not only desired, but expected by the majority of bus riders.

A 2013 survey from Single Point makes this abundantly clear.

The survey shows that 45.7% of bus riders considered Wi-Fi an important factor in their travel plans. A larger 52.1% of riders planned on using their phones' Wi-Fi while en route, and 48.5% planned to do some web browsing. And this was at a time when only 1.4% of buses included Wi-Fi!

The survey may be over five years old but still proves an interesting point: People want Wi-Fi on their buses.

They want to use their travel time to stay up-to-date, catch up on work, or just keep themselves entertained. It wouldn't be surprising if this survey was done again in the future and showed even larger numbers.

## Do Charter Buses Have USB Ports?

Our buses also include USB ports for charging your phone or tablet more directly.

Each seat has two USB ports installed into the wall beside them. That means all you need is your charging cord. No need to haul around your charging brick or a battery bank.

On our charter buses, you and your seatmate can both charge your USB devices in peace. Each passenger has their own USB outlet, meaning no disputes over who gets to charge what. If you're sitting solo, you could charge up to two USB devices at once!

The USB ports and outlets come in a 110V, as opposed to the average 220V you might get at home. This means a slower charge, but an equally efficient charge. You've got nothing but time on a bus ride, so you shouldn't notice a big difference.

You also shouldn't worry about battery damage. Some people believe charging a battery at a lower wattage than recommended is harmful to the battery. This is a myth, however.

While some charging bricks have voltage limits, phones do not. That means it's safe to plug directly into the USB port given.

When it comes to the latest smartphones, you can charge your device in any outlet between 110v and 240v. This includes iPhones, Google Pixel devices, and Samsung Galaxy phones. Voltage limits are really a thing of the past, and you shouldn't be too concerned about them.

You can charge any number of devices with a simple USB port, including:

- Tablets (iPad, Galaxy Tablet, etc.)
- Laptop Computers
- E-readers (Kobo, Kindle, etc.)
- Phone (iPhone, Pixel, Galaxy, Razr, etc.)
- Gaming Consoles (Nintendo Switch, 3DS, PSP, etc.)
- Vaporizer/e-cigarette (Juul, etc.)
- Cameras
- Battery Banks

## **Do Charter Buses Have Outlets?**

Yes, all our charter buses—and most charter buses in general—come equipped with outlets.

Outlets have become a staple of public and private transportation in the last decade. More and more city bus companies are installing outlets into their buses. Lately, Toronto, Canada has made the move to include USBs, Wi-Fi, and outlets in their GO buses.

Each of the seats in our charter buses includes two easily accessible outlets. You can use this to charge your phone, laptop, and anything else you might bring with you. It's a real relief knowing you don't have to worry about your devices dying while on that long bus ride.

There's no need to fight about who gets to charge what, either. With four ports total (two USB, two electrical outlets) that means each passenger can charge multiple devices at once. You and your seatmate can charge your phone and laptop at once in peace.

As with USB ports, the outlets run at a somewhat lower 110 volts. Again, you have nothing to worry about. You'll be looking at a bit of a longer charge time, but you won't be damaging your battery at all.

## **Is It Safe to Use Bus Wi-Fi?**

Some people are wary of using public Wi-Fi, including Wi-Fi on buses.

Although charter and coach buses aren't technically "public," the Wi-Fi is still seen as less secure than a home connection. People think of it as using Wi-Fi in a coffee shop or a public library.

Any Wi-Fi connection that hosts a lot of people will always prove riskier than single-user Wi-Fi. Sharing a connection with others opens you up to potential security threats. You never know when there's a hacker in your midst.

When riding on our charter buses, you shouldn't worry too much about this. Ideally, you'll be traveling with people you know and trust. A co-worker or friend most likely won't risk breaching your privacy and risking their job or relationship.

If that doesn't put your mind at ease, though, you can use a Virtual Private Network (VPN).

A VPN allows you to connect to Wi-Fi securely and discreetly. It disguises your IP address, making it seem like you're browsing the web from a whole other country if you want. This will help stave off a lot of security threats, effectively making you anonymous on the web.

Most VPNs offer free trials if you don't want to make a full purchase just for one bus ride. You can get them on your phone, your computer, and your tablet. If you're the kind of person who's worried about their privacy, a VPN is a real must.

## **Is It Safe to Use Bus Outlets?**

Much like Wi-Fi, some people are wary about unfamiliar outlets, too. The reason might not be as obvious, but it is worth talking about.

People who are cautious with public outlets are probably worried about “juice jacking.” Juice jacking happens when you plug your device into a “hacked” USB port. This gives the hacker access to the files on your phone, allows them to record your screen, and more.

Juice jacking can happen through outlets and USB ports.

It’s important to be cautious when plugging your phone into public outlets. However, the outlets on our buses are not public. When you rent a charter bus from us, you can rest assured knowing that our outlets are 100% safe to use.

## **How long is Aircoach from Belfast to Dublin?**

How long does a bus trip from Belfast to Dublin Airport take? The quickest transfer from Belfast to Dublin Airport is provided by Aircoach and takes 1h 50m.

## **Are buses running from Dublin to Belfast?**

DoDublin's Freedom Ticket is the the only card in Dublin that can cover all your transport needs offering you 48 Hours Hop on Hop off tour as well as 72 hours of unlimited travel on Dublin's public transport network, which includes Airport Transfer on the 16 and 41 Dublin Bus routes.

## **Does Leap card work on bus to Airport?**

Get unlimited travel over your selected time period on Dublin Bus, Go-Ahead Ireland routes in Dublin, Luas, DART and Commuter Rail. You can even travel to and from the Airport at the start and end of your trip without any additional charge .

## **How much is the bus from Dublin Airport to city Centre?**

Tickets. Aircoach tickets can be bought online or from customer staff at Dublin Airport. A return ticket from Dublin Airport to O'Connell Street (Dublin City Centre) typically costs around 9 Euros.

## **Can I use free travel pass on Irish Ferries?**

Only the named person can use the Free Travel Pass, you cannot let another person use it. To travel for free you must always produce your Free Travel Pass for inspection to the ferry operator.

## **Can Leap card be used on Dublin express?**

TFI Leap Card can now be used on the Collins Coaches' Dublin Commuter Service to purchase Single and 10 Journey Tickets using Travel Credit . You must have sufficient credit on your TFI Leap Card before you purchase a ticket from the driver.

## **How much is a bus ticket from Dublin to Cork?**

The average bus ticket from Dublin to Cork costs around \$12 for departures 1 days prior. Over the last 60 days, ticket prices from Dublin to Cork vary and during peak season, ticket prices are around \$20 while at other times, you can expect to pay around \$16.

## **Do you tip taxi drivers in Ireland?**

Taxi drivers in Ireland are generally not expecting a tip, but you can round up your fare to the nearest even amount if you like. If you take a shuttle from the airport, you don't have to tip your driver but you can give €1 per bag if they assist you with your luggage.

## **Are taxis safe in Dublin?**

## **Is Dublin safe?**

Yes! Ireland has frequently ranked among the safest countries in the world, and although Dublin is regarded as the most dangerous area of the country, it is still a relatively safe place to visit.

## **Do you have to wear a mask in Dublin Airport?**

While it is no longer mandatory to wear a face mask in Irish airports, Dublin Airport still recommends using masks in and around the airport. Official guidance from the airport's website states that "wearing a mask or face covering reduces the risk of spreading COVID-19 and helps protect us all.

## **Is a Covid test required to fly to Ireland?**

Entry and Exit Requirements From 6 March 2022, all COVID-19 travel restrictions are removed. You no longer need to complete a passenger locator form. You also no longer need proof of vaccination or recovery, or a COVID-19 test .

## **Can you sleep overnight in airport?**

At some airports, there will be places where you can pick up a blanket and pillow if you're stuck there overnight. This is especially true if your flight has been cancelled or delayed due to weather. Sometimes there are even cots available! While many airports don't have this, it never hurts to ask.

## **Is there a toilet on the Aircoach Cork to Dublin?**
