That is why you trust that you now have to pick between the two: striking look and safety. And can it be that those awesome tires match your trim? And is it even possible to incorporate tires of a larger size? Well, stay calm - you are in the right palms of specialists who have spent so many years gathering all sorts of data to help people just like you come to a decision.

For this reason, let's start with the safety aspects of your own 2008 Toyota Prius: our general piece of advice is always to switch tires with the initial size ones - defined by the manufacturer. Replacing a detail for a non-authentic one could have effect on functionality of the vehicle. Moreover, changing tires for non-original things will certainly imply guarantee coverage. The following are charts with every available 2008 Toyota Prius trim, and thus customers just need to type these pieces of information and plus a year of manufacture to view totally all the options straightaway.

And lastly, as soon as you replace tires, don't ignore the fact that you have to keep them in satisfactory order. Attempt to constantly examine the pressure and monitor the tread wear. In America, you aren't allowed to have a protector under 2/32".
