Considering Usage

The idea of having more shots available in a handgun sounds like it would be useful in all situations. However, extended magazines are best used for target shooting and trips to the range. The increased possibility, however small, of feeding issues makes them a poor choice for a home defense pistol.

The extra length extending from the magazine well also makes them a poor choice to concealed carry. Extended magazines are also sometimes outlawed in certain areas so make sure to check your local laws and regulations before making any purchases.

Multiple Mags

While a single extended magazine will certainly still be useful on the range, the real payoff comes when you have multiple extended mags available. The leisure of slamming a fully loaded extended mag into your Taurus G2C mere moments after emptying another one cannot be overstated. If you spend a ton of time on the range or just enjoy rapid fire shooting sessions uninterrupted by reloading, invest in as many extended mags as you comfortably can afford.

Practice Both Ways

Using extended mags to reduce time spent reloading on the range is a great idea for those longer shooting sessions. However, you don't want to get too used to only using extended mags. This is especially true if you use your Taurus G2C for other purposes where the use of an extended mag isn't ideal. The extra length extending from the grip will alter the way you handle your pistol even if only slightly.

Additionally, the extra added weight can cause you to compensate in ways you might not notice but that may affect your shot when using standard capacity rounds. That being said, make sure to still spend time shooting your Taurus G2C without extended mags to ensure your skills stay sharp and your shot stays true in varying situations.

Review of the Best Taurus G2C Extended Magazines

How to Choose a G2C Extended Mag

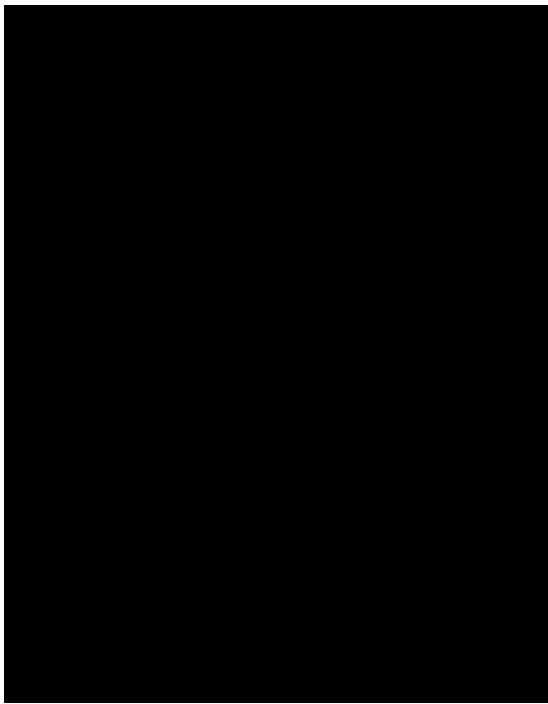

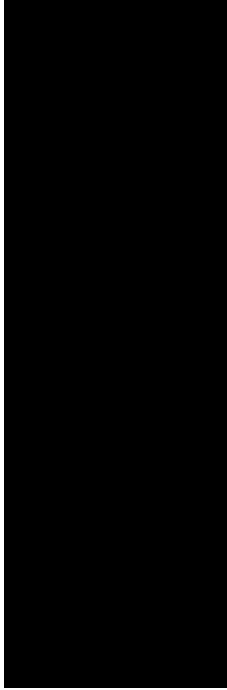

Not to mention reloading becomes 1,000 times more difficult in a high-pressure, self-defense situation for the average shooter, which can lead to a fumbled reload.

That's why many people own semi-automatic pistols. Semi-autos offer the ability to carry more ammo in a magazine body than a revolver's cylinder. However, some guns, such as the Taurus G2C, only come with 10 or 12 round factory magazines, while other semi-autos enable the user to pack 15+ rounds with a double-stacked, offset, or staggered configuration.

I carry a small pistol that came with a 7+1 standard capacity magazine from the factory. Before I left the gun store, I bought a couple of extended magazines for two reasons. The first was that my pinky didn't have any grip, so I had to adjust my grasp, and I didn't like that. The following reason is that I would rather carry fewer mags without sacrificing capacity, so I don't have to reload as often if I am forced to defend myself.

I have been in your shoes. I have had to pause target practice to reload magazines far too often — and have purchased extended magazines for multiple firearms, but especially to replace the standard magazine of compact pistols I carry for self-defense. I'm here to help new and experienced gun enthusiasts alike to make the best choice when choosing an extended mag for your Taurus G2C.

Fit

An extended mag can help the gun fit more comfortably in your hand with a grip extension. Many compact guns require you to grip the firearm differently from a full-size pistol, so adding an extended mag allows you to use your regular grip.

Why Use an Extended Mag for Your Taurus G2C?



Many people prefer to carry at least 15 rounds on them. However, the Taurus G2C only offers a 12 round factory magazine. So in order to reach this minimum threshold we look to purchase extended mags.

There are many reasons for wanting an extended mag. Having more rounds loaded means you won't have to reload as much. Reloading is costly and becomes immensely more difficult during a high-pressure situation. Reducing the times you have to reload is critical, which makes extended magazines important.

I used to hear my grandpa say "it's better to have a gun and not need it, than not have a gun and need it." I think the same rings true about ammunition because a gun is just a paper weight until you load it. An extended mag gives you more opportunity to hit your target. When you're under stress you will not be as accurate as you are normally. Unless you train in a high-stress environment.

The need for a Taurus extended mag can also be for comfort. As I mentioned earlier one of my carry pistols isn't large enough for my pinky to grip without an extended magazine.

Lastly, it's okay to just want one. We live in America, where we love our guns and firearm accessories.

Shortcomings of Taurus G2C Extended Magazines

- Negative Associations. Extended mags often get a negative connotation because, in several states, they are illegal due to them being "high-capacity magazines." Most gun control advocates claim that the number of mass shooting victims would be cut in half without high-capacity mags. That's why many states are beginning to ban them and enact strict laws against magazines that hold more than ten rounds.
- Additional Weight. By themselves, individual rounds aren't heavy. However, the weight quickly adds up as you load the bullets into a magazine and impact the way your pistol shoots. The extra weight can affect your accuracy, and the longer mag can snag on your clothing or environment much easier.
- A Challenge to Conceal. A larger mag is much more difficult to conceal. Which means you are more prone to printing. This means people around you can see that you are carrying a firearm because your clothing outlines it.
- Potential Feeding Issues. Through my personal experience, I find that extended mags are not smooth feeding. Maybe that's just my bad luck, or I bought the wrong magazine. These feeding issues are often a result of the spring malfunctioning.

After reading all the reviews of the Taurus G2C extended magazines listed above, I did not see many complaints about improper feeding unless a steel casing was used instead of a brass casing for the bullets.

Legal Considerations

You also can't afford to overlook the legal factors. Many states have enacted restrictions or outright bans on high-count magazines. "Large-capacity" means it carries more than ten rounds, according to the gun control lobbyist website giffords.org. These restrictions impact the legality of extended magazines, so read up before taking the plunge into extended magazines.

The following states have laws restricting large-capacity magazines:

- Hawaii
- Maryland
- Massachusetts
- New Jersey
- New York
- Vermont
- Washington DC

Price Ranges vs. Features

The price stays pretty consistent for Taurus extended magazines. You should expect to pay between \$25 and \$100. The main factor that determines price is round capacity. A majority of the mags will be below \$50.

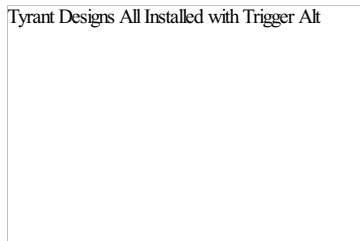
