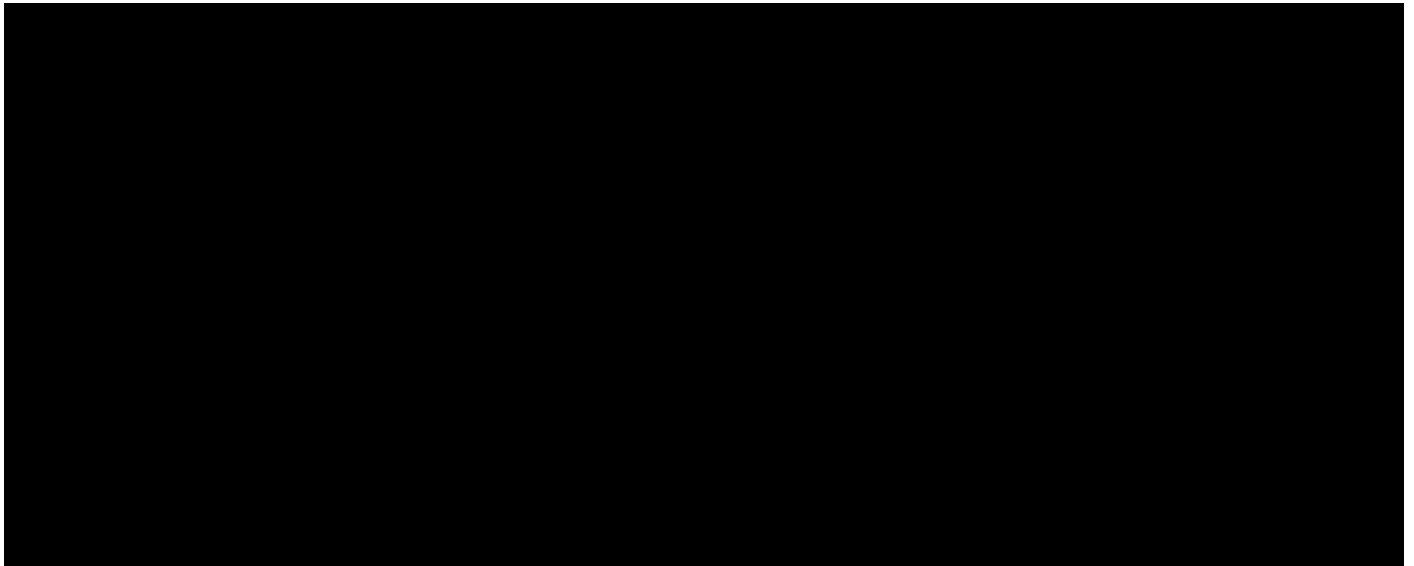
Imperial vs Metric

There are two type of ruler mesearment unit imperial as we know Inches and metric also called Centimeter. In a imperial ruler (Inches) we work on fraction but in metric ruler (Centimeter) we don't work on fraction instead of fraction we use points system in the metric ruler.

What is a Inches?

The inches is a part of the Imperial system and mainly use in United State of America (USA). In a standard inches ruler is 12 inches wide or one foot in worldwide. Like in the metric ruler (Centimeter) we don't work on fraction instead of fraction we use points system in the metric ruler but in imperial ruler (Inches) we work on fraction.

How to read Inches ruler?



We knew that the standard inch ruler is 12 inches long or 1 foot long. Which means that 12 inches long ruler divided into 12 equal parts. In one part there are some vertical lines. Some lines are smaller and some are longer. And this lines called as a fraction of inches.

There are three types of inches ruler 1/8, 1/16, 1/32. In 1/8 inches ruler one inches divided by 8 verticle lines In 1/16 inches ruler one inches divided by 16 verticle lines. And the last one 1/32 inches ruler divided by 32 verticle lines. All this verticle lines called as fraction of inches or Graduation of inches. Like 1/8, 1/4, 3/8, 1/2, 5/8, 3/4, 7/8.

First, we discuss 1/2 inches, 1/2 inches are mid on the whole inches and it's the longest line after that inches.

After that second-longest verticle line are 1/4 and 3/4 and as we have seen on the image it appears in mid on the 1/2 inches.

1/8, 3/8, 5/8, 7/8 appear mid of the 1/4 and 3/4 inches and these lines are the smallest verticle lines on the ruler.

First, we discuss 1/2 inches, 1/2 inches are mid on the whole inches and it's the longest line after that inches.

After that second-longest verticle line are 1/4 and 3/4 and as we have seen on the image it appears in mid on the 1/2 inches.

1/8, 3/8, 5/8, 7/8 appear mid of the 1/4 and 3/4 inches and these lines are the smallest verticle lines on the ruler.

How to Convert Inches to CM

Convert inches to Centimetres use this formal Centimetres = Inches x 2.54 . For example, you convert 12 inches to Centimetres. Centimetres =12 x 2.54, After that, you get 30.48 Inches.

The history of measurement scales has been quite varied and extensive. In the past, many different distance units were used to measure the length of an object. In the absence of any standard unit for measurement, people utilized body parts such hand, foot and cubit for the purpose of measuring any height of any object or humans. These units were not uniform and varied in length from one era to another. With the development of metric system in late 18th century a uniform measurement system came into existence and standards in respect to measurement were set. The system was adopted by all the countries across the world and it was then when a standard scale for measuring Centimeter and Inch was devised.

Centimeter: A unit of length, a centimeter is equivalent to 100th of a meter. Centimeter is also termed or is known as the base unit of length and is used as the standard unit of measurement for measuring height of a person or an object. Being the standard unit of length, centimeter finds greater acceptability in daily life and is considered as the best pragmatic approach for routine measurements.

Uses of centimeter

- To measure the height of a person or any object.
- To claim the amount of rainfall with the help of a rain gauge
- Centimeter is also used in maps to convert the map scale into practical world distances

Inch: A customary unit of length, an inch is equal to 2.54 centimeters. The standard length for the inch varied from place to place in the past and it was in the year 1959 that International Yard was defined and Inch was measured exact the same length all over the world. A yard was defined as 36 inches on an inch scale and 0.9144 meters to be precise. An inch is denoted by the sign in' and it is represented by double prime.

Uses of Inch scale

Inch is used as a standard unit of measurement of length for electronic products like TV and computer screen as well as Mobiles.

The scale of inch is also used in the measurement of objects like doors, ceilings as well as other items that are shorter than a meter and are not practical to be measured with centimeters.

How to convert centimeters into inches

It is a known fact that one inch equates to 2.54 centimeters and vice versa. To simply convert centimeters into inches you can simply divide the given number of inches with 2.54 and you can convert easily centimeters into each.

Another quite easy way to convert centimeters into inches is by taking the help of inches and Cm scales. The scale is given number of centimeters as well as inches after each 2.54 centimeter and helps you to convert cm into inches. This method is limited to size of scale and you cannot convert infinite number of centimeters.

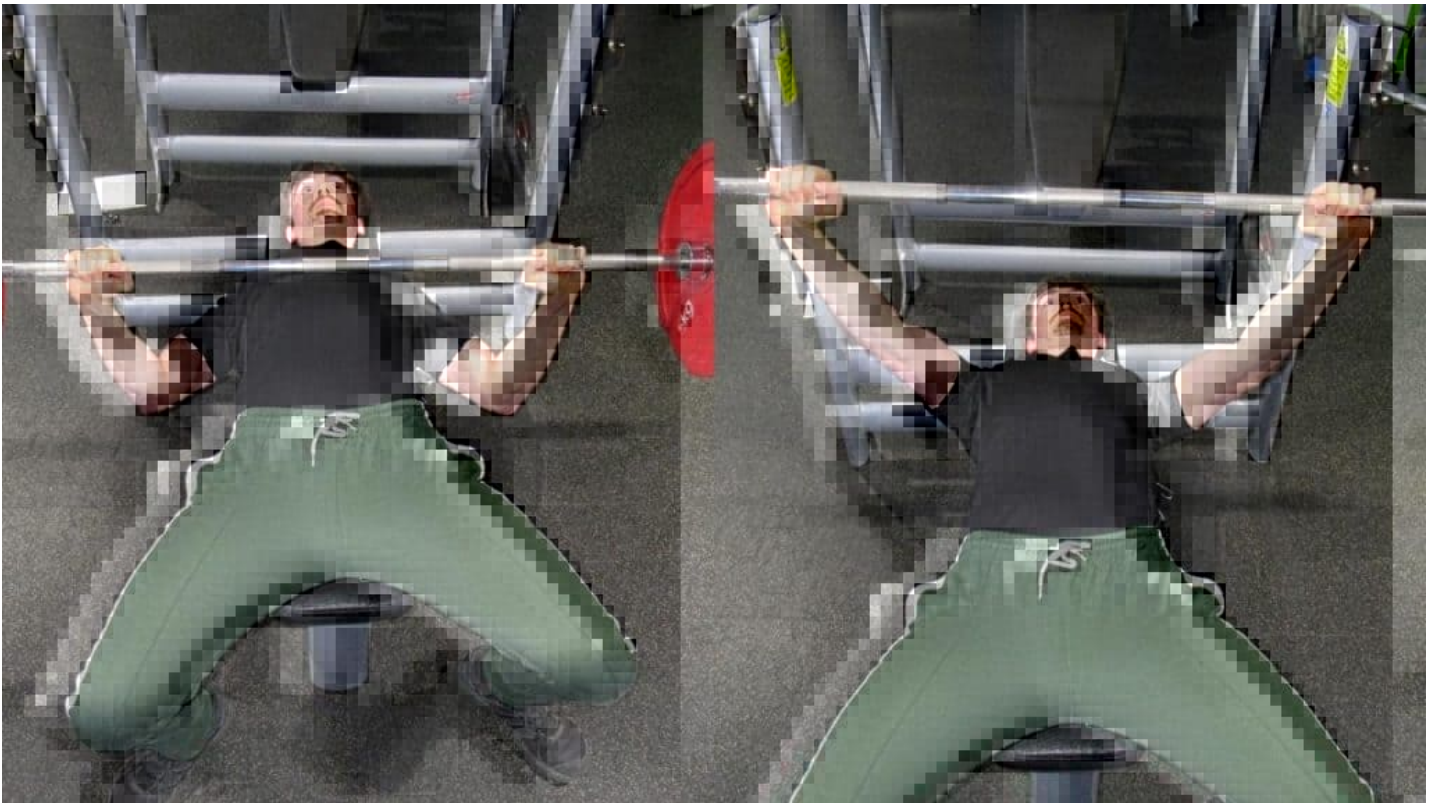

What is 5 Ft Long in Inches?

Assuming you are talking about converting 5 feet to inches, this is a relatively simple task. There are 12 inches in a foot, so all you need to do is multiply 5 by 12. This gives you the answer of 60 inches.

Now, if you want to know how to convert from feet to inches without using multiplication, that's a bit more complicated. The easiest way to do it is by using a converter or calculator, but if you want to do it manually there's a bit more math involved. 
